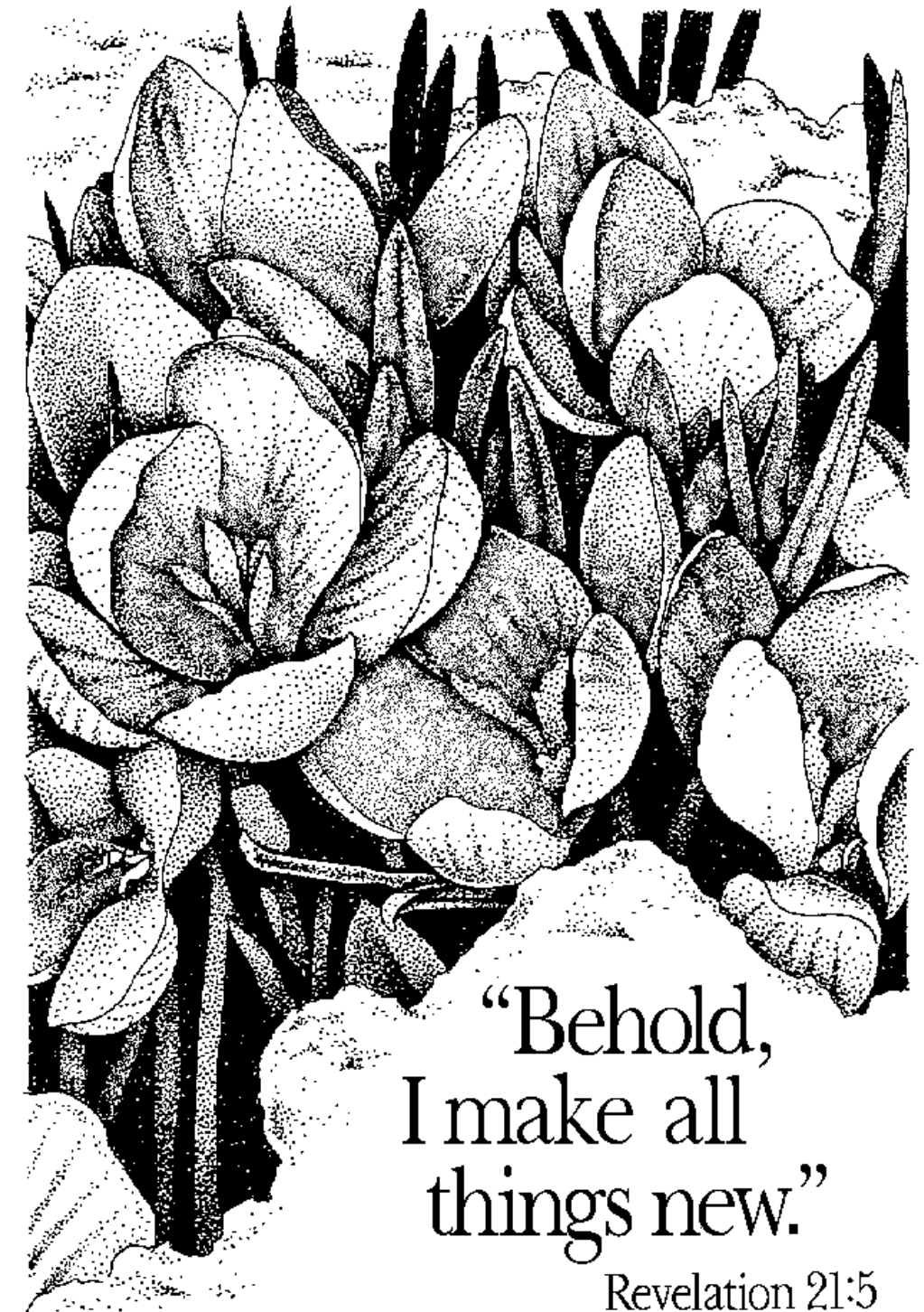

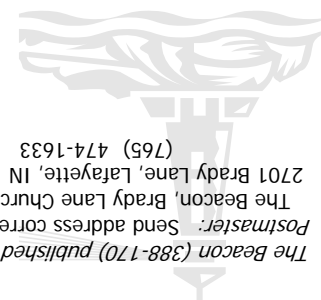

Minister's Minute

Sunday we looked at some tips for having better families. It is clear that having a great family, with good relationships is often difficult. Perhaps the key to improving your family is simply to draw up your own list of things you value and need to improve.

Here is another list that may help you get started. Gary Chapmen in his book *"Five Signs of a Functional Family"* suggests this list of musts:

An attitude of service.

When family members help each other the whole family benefits. Changing the world always starts at home!

Parents who teach and train

Guiding your children is a team effort. Parents, not the school or the church, must offer guidance and training. Lovingly discipline your children. Teach them right and wrong.

Intimacy between a husband and wife.

When a couple connects, it satisfies

their inner longings and gives the children a loving model of what family is all about. Love has to be the heart of the home. Love is often caught rather than taught.

Husbands who are loving leaders.

A man needs to lead his wife and children in a loving way and live his spiritual and moral values. It inspires his family to do the same.

Children who obey and honor their parents.

Kids need to learn that living by rules is good for them and everyone around them. Teach them to respect adults, and value their friendships. Establish boundaries and keep them.

Now it's your turn. Our world needs strong, growing families. Don't forget that the Gospel will never make a difference in the world, if it has not made a difference at home first. Grow your family this week. See you Sunday.
