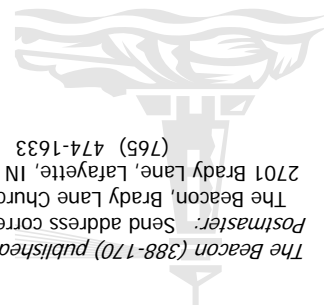

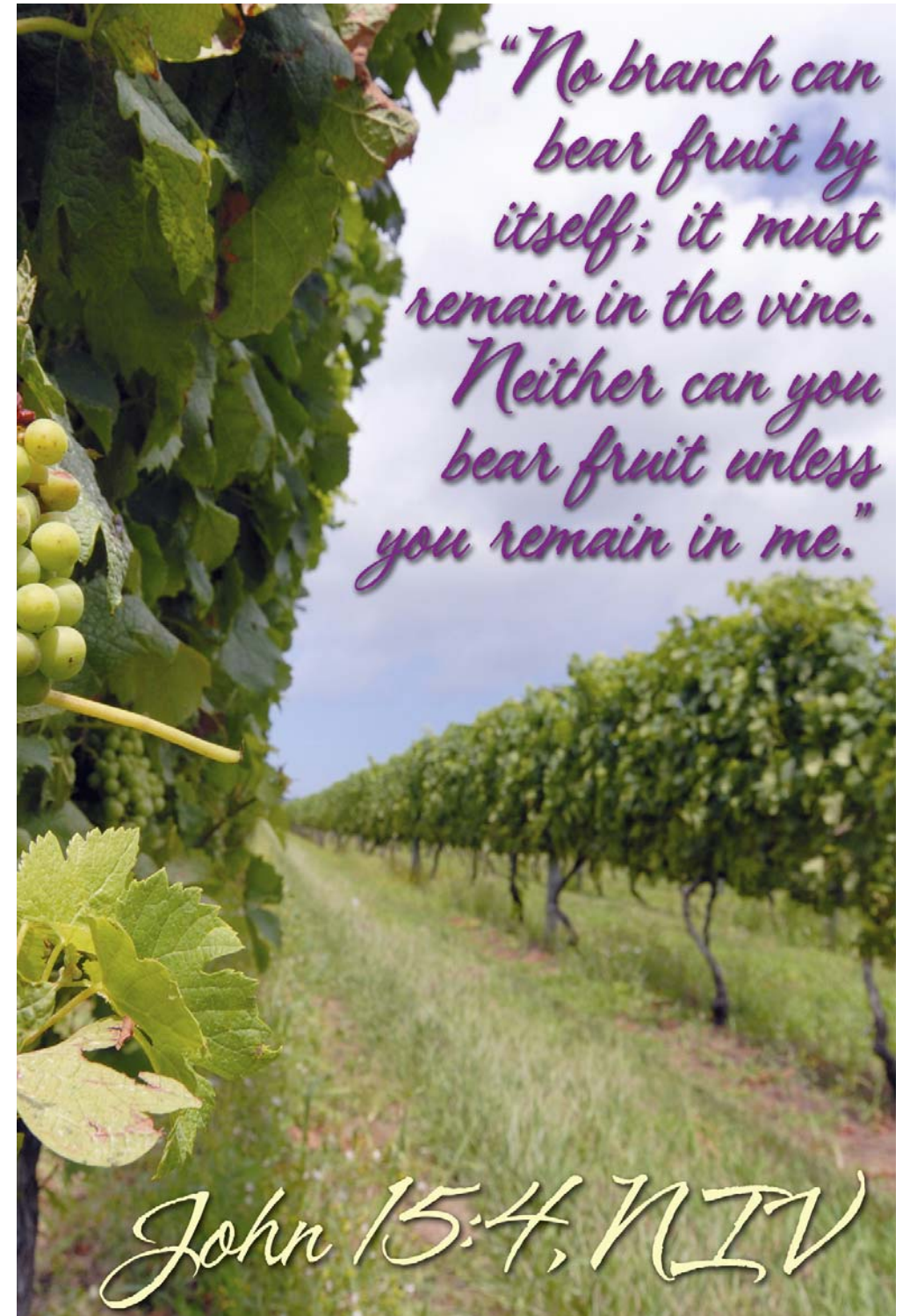

Restoration House Ministries This Week

Indiana is the promised land! We have just over six hundred Christian Churches in the state, exceeding any other state in the nation. That number is great, but can keep us from remembering that our presence in many of the most populous areas of the nation is almost nonexistent. In the core north east states we have only twenty churches total. That makes the ministry of Restoration House so important. In less than twenty years, Restoration House has the prime force in establishing, supporting, and growing thirteen congregations in the Northeast. In addition the organization has provided over sixty college classes to train leaders for these churches, sponsored over 80 interns to served in evangelism, and has had nine of these interns return to work fulltime in these new churches.

Mike Shryock, the Directory of New Church Plan Administration, for Restoration House Ministries will be with us this Sunday to share the latest mission news, progress in New England, and information on how you can be involved in new church work. Mike will share the message during both worship experiences, and will offer a first-hand report during the Sunday School hour, as we meet together in the Fellowship Hall.
