Masks Required in 1st Service

At our elders meeting this past Tuesday night, a 45 minute conversation sparked a decision to come to those who are currently attending first service (8:30am) and ask a simple question. If you knew your brothers and sisters who we have missed these last 7 months would come back to church if we helped them to feel safe would you help us do that?

The leadership team of BLC believes that the time has come to put aside the thoughts and feelings that divide and strive toward a reunification of our family at BLC.

Beginning September 13, 2020 we will be asking that everyone who attends first service **please do so wearing a mask**. This is being done in an attempt to raise the comfort level of those who are still not back with us yet on Sunday morning.

If you arrive and have forgotten a mask, one will be provided for you at the door.

We will be making this announcement live at both services this coming Sunday, September 6th.

Second service, at 11am, will continue to operate under the guidelines we have been following all along - masks to sing, but otherwise not required. Social distancing still requested and hand sanitizing stations are still set up throughout the facility.
